**** Information Regarding the Passover Meal Plan ****

March 2008

As many of you know, the Jewish festival of Passover commences this year on Saturday evening, April 19th. Once again, we are providing a Passover Meal Plan, which will provide Kosher for Passover lunches and dinners for the eight days of Passover. As a reminder - you do not have to be on the meal plan in order to attend Seders.

This notice describes this year's meal plan and Seder arrangements.

What is the Passover Meal Plan?

First of all, the Passover Meal Plan is *not* a part of Sodexo (RPI meal plans). Fortunately, excellent meals are cooked for us by the Troy Lubavitch center, disguised in the person of Leible Morrison, family, and friends.

How are Seders working this year?

The first and second Seders are on the nights of Saturday, April 19th, and Sunday, April 20th, respectively. Both Seders will begin at 8pm in the Shelnutt Gallery, Student Union room 3606. If you will be attending either of the Seders, please check the appropriate lines on the Registration Form.

When and what meals are provided?

For the remainder of Passover, and for lunch between the two Seders, the times are as follows:

Lunch: 11:00 A.M. – 1:30 P.M.
Dinner: 5:00 – 7:30 P.M. (except Seders)

Please Note:

- On Sunday 4/20, Saturday 4/26, or Sunday 4/27 brunch will be served starting at 10:30 A.M.

Where are the meals served?

All meals will be held in the Shelnutt Gallery, Student Union room 3606. At all meals there will be a sign-up sheet at the door. Please sign it when you come in.
